

24 Year Old Single Malt Whisky

DISTILLED ON THE ISLE OF ARRAN

In 2012, a friend of Nicolas' put him in touch with someone who had purchased two casks of single malt whisky that were distilled on the isle of Arran, in Scotland. It turned out that getting casks from Scotland to the US wasn't as easy as they anticipated, so they decided to part ways with the whisky. Nicolas acquired these casks – his first non-Cognac purchase – and shipped them to his cellar in Cognac in the summer of 2012.

The whisky in these bottles was **distilled in 1996**, one year after the distillery opened. They aged from 1996 to 2012 in Scotland before being moved to France, where they aged further in Cognac casks until their bottling in the summer of 2020, making this single malt whisky **24 years old**, despite the 23 years noted on the label. Sometimes you have labels made but don't get to bottling something until the following year!
